

Emergency Egress Options

SPECIFICALLY FOR ULTI ROLL HIGH SPEED DOORS

In the event of an emergency or power outage, it is important that your doors are still able to operate or function as an exit to ensure the safety of your people. With our Ulti Roll high speed doors, there are a number of emergency egress options available, which can be selected according to your unique needs, enabling you to meet these safety requirements.

Manual Hand Crank (Standard)

The Manual Hand Crank allows personnel to manually open/close the door. A robust solution, it is operated by manually cranking the handle, and is included with all Ulti Roll door systems as standard. Additionally, it includes magnetic holders for the storage of the handle during normal day-to-day operation of the door.



Manual Hand Chain

The Manual Hand Chain system allows personnel to manually open/close the door by pulling on the chain. A more user-friendly option and always in position, ready for immediate use when the need arises, this system is the ideal option for quick and easy emergency operation of the door.



Manual Release

The counterweight Manual Release system is activated by pulling the release lever. Once released, the door curtain will rise to a partly open position allowing personnel egress. Due to the counterweight balancing, the door will remain in this position until the release lever is repositioned to its standard position and the control panel manual reset is completed by the operator. With no electrical components, this egress option is failsafe and ideal for application in any fire egress or similar critical egress situations, due to its ease of use and fast manual opening.



UPS Battery Backup

UPS Battery Backup is an emergency power supply unit which backs up the mains electrical supply to the door controller allowing the door to continue to function in its usual manner even in the event of a power outage. Unlike other egress options, this option requires no manual interaction making it the most simple to use.



Emergency Escape Zip

An emergency escape zip within the curtain where in the case of power failure or any similar emergency, personnel egress is easily accessed through the zip opening. Notably, this option maintains wind class integrity and with simplicity of operation, ease of restoring curtain integrity, and no requirement for personnel training, it's an effective alternative.
